



### AGRICULTURE AND AGRIFOOD INDUSTRY GROSS OUTPUT TREND 2009 - 2018




### **CONTRIBUTION TO GDP**



# **STATUS OF VEGETABLES INDUSTRY 2018**





- 5% of Agriculture and Agrifood Sector














# POULTRY INDUSTRY TARGETS 2016-2020



### AGRIFOOD INDUSTRY TARGET AND TRAJECTORIES 2016-2020


